## Programme content

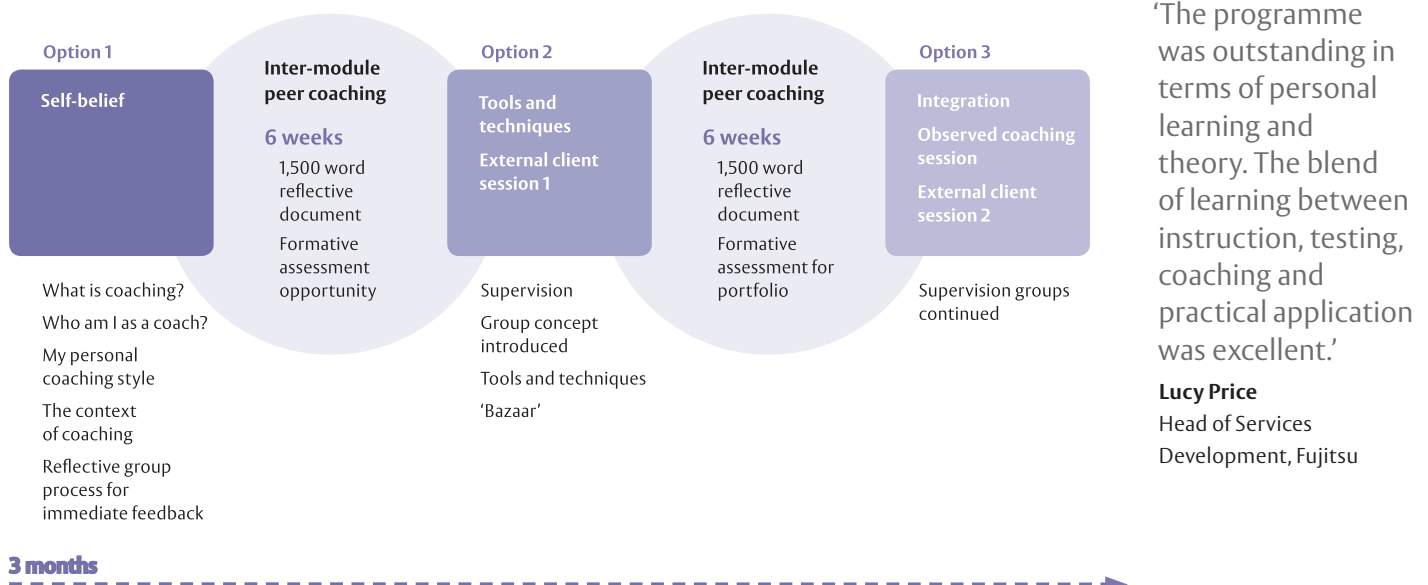
**Module 1** Self-belief module. This module explores your personal skills and attributes, beliefs and values around coaching.

**Module 2** Tools and techniques. This module enables you to try out different techniques and receive feedback. Each programme member runs an external client session.

**Module 3** Integration module. Tutor-observed coaching sessions offer feedback to include in your portfolio for assessment purposes, together with a second external client session.

## Qualification

After completing module 3, candidates must conduct three coaching relationships, obtaining feedback from their clients in each instance. A 5,000 word document reflecting on your development as a coach is the basis of the award of the Certificate, with subsequent accreditation for the Henley Register of Coaches.
